Title: Training Session on “Renewable Energies and Energy Efficiency in Andalusia for Municipality experts and businesses of the sector”

Date & location: 13th November 2006 - 4th December 2006, Salón de Actos, Edificio CIE, Diputación de Granada, Avda. de Andalucía s/n, 18015

Organiser: Agencia Andaluza de la Energía (Andalusian Energy Agency)

Short description: The training session undertakes the importance of the energy management of a municipality both from an energy saving and efficiency point of view: public lighting installations, town facilities, improvements in electricity billing etc, as well as from a renewable energy point of view: thermal solar, pv, biomass, mini-hydro and wind etc.

Background: Facing the need for planned local energy management which includes an integrated view of the implementation policies of renewable energies and energy efficiency, a training session has been organised by the Andalusian Energy Agency to provide the municipal experts/responsible in the Autonomous Community of Andalusia with detailed information on renewable energies and energy efficiency.

The training session, organised by the Andalusian Energy Agency (Agencia Andaluza de la Energía), with the collaboration of IDAE (Instituto para la Diversificación y el Ahorro de la Energía), and the Provincial Energy Agency of Granada, has been organised on Mondays and Tuesdays in order to make the training days more compatible with the general working week.



Aim & programme: The training session mainly targets the local actors, the experts and responsables of municipalities, in particular from Town/City Halls, engineers, architects, renewable energy installers, local and provincial energy agencies.

The opening session of the training session in Granada took place on 13th November 2006 by Yolanda Ibáñez, Counciller-Delegate of the County Council of Granada (Diputación Provincial) and President of the Provincial Energy Agency of Granada; Aurora Terrés, Head of Service, Provincial Delegation of Regional Ministry of Innovation, Science and Enterprise of Granada, who emphasised the current development of pv systems, and Maria Luisa Borra Marcos who discussed the European project RES-e Regions.
