Title: PV – training seminar for public actors
Date & location: 23 November 2005, Gothenburg

Short description:

This half day training seminar on PV attracted 42 persons including the speakers. Amongst them 14 persons represented 8 different municipalities in the region. There was also a range of architects, technicians, consultants and personnel from utilities and universities etc.

Background:

Due to the new support programme for grid-connected PV applications on public buildings the interest has rapidly increasing. However, this technology is in many cases very unproven and the knowledge amongst public employees and key stakeholders such as architects, building constructors, electric engineers, planners and real estate landlords and managers are very low.

There is a real need for an introduction and training on a range of issues in relation to the development of PV installations. This is not only concerning technical questions but also planning, system design, building applications and of course financing and economy.

Aim:

This half day seminar with information and educational speeches and presentations was targeted to key stakeholders in the public sector. The reason was to give the audience an overarching introduction on the technical, financial, planning and esthetical aspects of different kinds of PV technologies and applications on buildings.
